Soccer Spring Season Notes:

- 1) Remind your players for Fall registration.
 - a) Time to gather fall game conflicts for you and the team. We will be requesting them soon.
- 2) WSSL game reports must be mailed with in 24 hours. Game results are used for Spring divisioning.
 - b) Game ID # to be used on all game reports.
 - c) Rescheduling use the guidelines on the Northville website.
 - d) Field Status Hotline, check before going to the fields, remind your parents. 248 449-9951
 - e) The WSSL website will be posting other communities' hotline as well.
 - f) As soon as you find out your home game field is canceled, call the opposing team.
 - g) Corrections to the WSSL coaches info are on the WSSL site, in the Adm area.
 - h) WSSL game reports, mark clearly if you or your player is sitting out for a subse.
- 3) Volunteers are needed: Commissioners, Equipment, Field Development, Goals, ect...
- 4) All teams must have an Assistant of record. Let your commissioner.
- 5) All recreation players must have equal playing time. No penalties for missed practices.
- 6) Coaches are encouraged to take CPR, First Aid any coaching class, many are listed below
- 7) Thunder or lightning at first signs of, end practice and / or game, go to a safe shelter.

Lightning can strike as far as 15 mile from the source.
- 8) Coaches, parents and Referees: please check goals and make sure they are secured.
- 9) Northville Soccer has donated books and DVDs to our Northville Library for coach's education.
- 10) Help us organizing a 3V3 Tourney here in Northville, to raise funds to offset new P&R Costs
- 11) Trash must be picked up by the teams responsible.**
- 12) NSA Adult Summer League: Over 30's, Coed and Youth
